- o Established policy for all new buildings to be LEED Silver
- o Procure Energy Star certified products were available

New Academic Center

- o Building will be Silver Certified
- o Replaced major mechanical systems to achieve a 60% energy savings
- o New lighting system
- o Removing sprinkler system by using native landscaping
- o Enhanced building commissioning

- Best Practices

- o New Air Handler Units fitted with VFD and CO2 sensors
- o Low VOC paints and finishes
- o Recycling program (composting, single stream)
- o Green cleaning products
- o Linen reuse
- o Green Seal Certification
